

Located in the northern half of Spain in the region of Castile and León, Soria has a population of 40,000 people. It lies along the River Duero and enjoys summer temperatures between 73°F and 82°F.

This camp is designed for students between the ages of 12 and 17, and it is certain to be a highlight of your child’s formative years. The language program will be conducted at our partner academy with native teachers certified by the Instituto Cervantes. There are 20 lessons each week geared toward the practical use of Spanish.

Other daily activities include walking tours, movies, drama lessons, crafts, sports, dance lessons and cooking classes. In addition there are escorted day trips to nearby cities and a weekend trip to the Basque Country including the seaside city of San Sebastian.

During the camp period your child will live with a carefully chosen and supervised host family. Living with a family is the most effective way for your child to learn and practice Spanish. Some host families have children of their own which adds even more to your child’s experience. No learning experience compares with living with people who use the language every day. And it offers your child the chance to observe and appreciate a different culture and style of life.
