

Immersion Preschool and Homeschool Enrichment

The best time to learn a second language is the early years in one's life. We live in a globalized society where the importance of speaking multiple languages and understanding cultural differences is an essential aspect.

Our preschool implements a Montessori-inspired curriculum that teaches listening, speaking, reading and writing in the Spanish language. We use songs, games, physical movement, arts and crafts, creative play, and other fun, interactive methods to engage students.

We also offer Homeschool Enrichment in the mornings for ages five through eight. These classes use the same teaching methods as the preschool, but learning concepts are taught at a higher academic level.

Our preschool and morning homeschool enrichment class sizes are small, with a maximum of five students in each class. This allows the teacher to differentiate instruction based on your child's strengths and needs.

We also offer after school classes for children and teens. We teach Spanish through fun, creative and engaging activities. We are committed to providing small class sizes and personal attention. Study Abroad in Spain

Older students who are ready to take their Spanish skills to the next level have the exciting opportunity to study in Spain during the summer. The program is located in the small, quaint town of Soria, Spain at the OUI & YES! Spanish Centre. Applicants take a placement test and are then grouped according to age and knowledge. Students take Spanish lessons Monday through Friday in the morning. Two afternoons a week, students also participate in cultural activities, such as art, dance and cooking classes. They are

housed in a student residence in individual or double rooms with bath. All meals are included. This is a great way to learn language and culture simultaneously!
